PYGMY RATTLESNAKE SPOTTED IN THE COMPLEX

As the weather becomes warmer, snakes will become more active and will be looking for a sunny spot to warm themselves. Be aware when walking, especially with your dog. The pygmy rattler is a 12” - 24” grayish snake with a series of dark, almost black, blotches on its back. It is one of the most commonly seen venomous snakes and most likely to defend itself when threatened. You might also see cottonmouth water moccasins (can be banded reddish brown to black, and when threatened will open its mouth to reveal a cottony white inside), or coral snakes (black & red bands with smaller yellow bands in between; it has a black snout. Remember this old

saying “Red touch black, safe for Jack. Red touches yellow, kills a fellow”). Please give them a wide berth! Report sightings to Coastal Management / Whitney Buss, Jonathan Rucker, or Sheila Pellicer when she’s at the Clubhouse Office on Thursdays.

IDES OF MARCH; MARCH 15TH

The Ides of March was a day in the Roman calendar. It had several religious meanings (the Spring Equinox for one), but was known best as a deadline for settling debts. The Roman calendar didn’t number the days of the month but counted back from three fixed points of the month; the Nones, the Ides (being sacred to the

god Jupiter), and the Kalends. Originally, the Ides were determined by the full moon, with the Ides of March being the first full moon of the new year. The Ides of March is probably most notable for the date that Julius Caesar was assassinated in 44 BC.
