For pest control, BH has a service which is on-site monthly to spray around the buildings and in the walkways for bug control. The contract we have with this company also includes pest control inside your unit. If you are having an inside issue, contact Whitney Buss at Coastal Management to make arrangements for the pest control vendor to come to your unit.

Our cleaning company is also working to maintain the walkways in our buildings; they are done in each building once a month on a rotating basis.

If you want your lanai, lanai screening, or windows cleaned (you are responsible for the care and cleaning of these elements of your unit), you will have to hire an outside vendor and pay them directly.

SUMMER SOLSTICE

This day that astronomically marks the start of summer, has the longest daylight hours in the Northern Hemisphere. The sun travels its farthest northern path on this day. June 3: Chimborazo Day; Chimborazo is an interesting mountain in Ecuador; the highest point on Earth if you measure from the Earth's core. It is very important in geographic history as it was one of two points used to determine the actual shape of our Earth – an oblate spheroid.

June 6: National Yo-Yo Day; I never could get the hang of this...have you ever tried it out?

June 8: Upsy Daisy Day;

National Upsy Daisy Day is set aside for you to understand that every day is a gift, and to encourage you to face the day positively and to get up 'gloriously, gratefully, and gleefully' each morning!
