

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS SHEET

Name of Condominium Association

Q: What are my voting rights in the condominium association?

A: One vote per unit

Q: What restrictions exist in the condominium documents on my right to use my unit?

A: Residential use only, no more than 4 occupants. Garages to be used only for parking and storage of personal items.
See section 10 of Declaration

Q: What restrictions exist in the condominium document on the leasing of my unit?

A: Minimum 7 months. No timeshares or subleases.
See section 10.2 of Declaration

Q: How much are my assessments to the condominium association for my unit type and when are they due?

A: Assessments in the amount indicated on the current year's approved operating budget are due on the 15th of each month.

There are separate assessments for garages + elevators. Section 15 of Declaration

Q: Do I have to be a member in any other association? If so, what is the name of the association and what are my voting rights in this association? Also, how much are my assessments?

A: No

Q: Am I required to pay rent or land use fees for recreational or other commonly used facilities? If so, how much am I obligated to pay annually?

A: No

Q: Is the condominium association or other mandatory membership association involved in any court cases in which it may face liability in excess of \$100,000? If so, identify each such case.
