PARKING PERMITS – PERMANENT & VISITOR .

All vehicles that are “housed” here in Belle Haven must display a permit parking sticker. Also, any guest staying overnight at Belle Haven must display a Visitor Parking Permit in their car (hanging from the rearview mirror or displayed on the front dashboard). Each resident / owner should have two of these visitor parking permits.



If you need a permanent parking permit or visitor parking permits, please see Linda at the Coastal Clubhouse office on Thursdays between 1 – 5 PM. Cars without permits or visitor parking permits are subject to being towed.

NO SMOKING IN BELLE HAVEN

There have been some questions about the no smoking policy in Belle Haven. There is no smoking in walkways, on balconies, patios, or lanais, in the clubhouse, pool area, parking areas or driveways that are within 20 ft. of a building. Smoking is permitted only in your own condo or outside if you are at least 20 ft. away from any building. You can find the documentation about the no smoking policy on our website:

FALL BACK – TO STANDARD TIME

On Sunday, November 7th, at 2:00 AM, turn your clocks back an hour to Standard Time. Upside – gain an hour’s sleep; Downside – gets darker earlier! Many states want to keep Daylight Saving Time permanently, but it would have to be voted on by Congress. The Sunshine Protection Act of 2021 (H.R. 69 proposed by Rep. Vern Buchanan of Florida in the 117th Congress) was introduced in January 2021 and has been referred to the subcommittee on Consumer Protection and Commerce. We’ll see what happens.
