ALLIGATOR FARM IN FEBRUARY

Visit the Alligator Farm's Wading Bird Rookery in February. Walking along the wooden walkways in the rookery, you will have incredibly intimate views of Florida's magnificent wading birds on their nests. In mid-February some of the Great Egrets arrive and begin nest building. Roseate Spoonbills stagger building their nests throughout the season, arriving as early as mid-January. In late February the Great Egret pairs start to lay eggs, alongside some arriving Wood Storks. In addition to all that is going on in the Rookery, you can see daily Alligator shows and see other mammals and birds in the Alligator Farm's conservation efforts through the SSP (Species Survival Plan). Take some time to visit this wonderful Zoological Park that has been around for over 125 years.

PARKING PERMITS – PERMANENT & VISITOR

All vehicles "housed" here in Belle Haven must have, and display, a permanent parking sticker, usually affixed to the back window of the vehicle. Any guest staying overnight at Belle Haven must display a Visitor Parking Permit in their car.



Each resident / owner should have two of these visitor parking permits. These parking permits and visitor parking permits can be obtained from the BH Coastal Office at the Clubhouse. Linda is in the office every Thursday from 1-5 PM. Vehicles without permits (permanent or visitor) are subject to being towed at the owner's expense.
